Tracking and supporting better NRM plans and planning processes

Are we getting better at regional natural resource management (NRM) planning or just treading water? This is the question being asked by the Healthy Savanna Planning Systems Project.

The project is working with regional NRM planners and policy makers to implement a 'real-time' 12-monthly evaluation and improvement cycle that aims to inform better regional NRM plan development, inform the evolution of planning arrangements in regions and capture what is learned and inform state and national policy making and delivery at regional and whole-of-savanna scales.

Monitoring regional plans and planning arrangements over time can help planners adapt and improve effectiveness of regional activities, investment and cooperation. Over the next three years, the project team will be working with planners, policy makers, key sectors and interests across Qld, WA and NT to design and deliver the project.
