Business Communication Training

Five regional bodies have now participated in the business communication training project including the Queensland Murray Darling Committee (QMDC), Fitzroy Basin Association, South West Natural Resource Management (SWNRM), Condamine Alliance and the Northern Gulf regional natural resource management (NRM) group. Three other groups have booked in for training over the next three months. The feedback so far has been positive and the standard of communication products being produced by these regional bodies has been very impressive. The project aims to assist regional bodies develop an awareness process that will lift their profile within their region.

This training is designed to build capacity within regional bodies to develop processes that will allow them to receive greater recognition within their region through the introduction of effective, consistent, and achievable internal and external communication processes.
